

The Planning Committee **RESOLVED** to **NOT SUPPORT** this application.

It was noted that this application was previously not supported by the planning committee at its meeting of the 19th of February 2024. The Planning Committee acknowledged that there were additional documents, however these had not addressed the previous concerns raised. Cllr Mitchell raised concerns that the scope of sewerage plans had not considered the 60-bed care home. He further observed that there should also be a geo-technical report, but it is absent from the application. There are also no drawings to show where the sewage plant will be or how it will be accessed.

In addition to concerns raised on the planning meeting of the 19th of February 2024, the details are inadequate in respect of the sewerage plant by way of location, means of access and maintenance. The outfall also needs to be validated by a geo-technical report, and falls short of H08 D, 1,2,3 & 4 of the Local Plan (Part 2). The application should include an ecology report assessing the post effect of the development and the impact on protected species and habitat. This is required prior to the determination of this application to ensure that impacts of the proposed development on the species and habitats are adequately assessed and considered as part of the decision-making process. The ecology update/survey should also cover species where there is a potential for breeding nesting birds to be present and completed by a suitably qualified ecologist. The site suitability for reptiles should also be assessed. The relevant ecology report should be presented to WNC before planning consent can be considered.


